## My Yard is Dying!

### What Do I Do?

Carroll County issued a complete outdoor watering ban early this summer as water levels fell to drastic deficits. The yards of Mill Pond have suffered. Due to these strict watering bans, we understand that you are not able to put "Weed & Feed" on your lawn as it does require watering to keep it from killing the grass. However, there are some things you can do to keep your yard healthy this season: 1) mow often and at a higher setting,

leaving at least 3" on the blade (a blade of grass goes as deep as it is high and the higher setting will allow the blade access to more water), 2) refrain from trimming bushes and trees unless you are sure there will be rainfall to help the plant recover, and finally, 3) remove dead plants (you are required to replace them, but we are aware that doing so during a draught may be a waste of money as the plant will more than likely die of shock).
