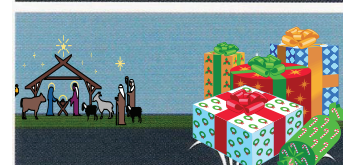
meeting of committee members and help you get started. The first week of December, the Landscape Committee met to discuss and form procedures for items that fall under their jurisdiction.

Cactus Care

Remember that your cactus have gone into their dormant stage and will require NO watering until March. The easiest way to kill your cacti is with too much water. This includes aloes and such. Most indoor plants do not enter a dormant stage

due to the mild, relatively stable temperatures in the home. Others will die from over watering during what would naturally be their dry season outdoors. Always consider, the best way to keep indoor plants healthy is to make them think they are outside.
